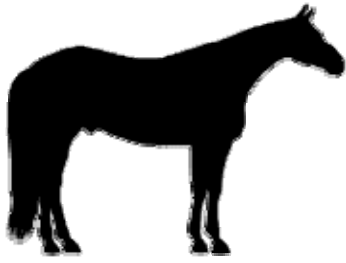

Rules and Regulations

What type of Queen are we looking for?

Junction City Saddle Club holds an application process annually to select a Queen to represent them in an array of activities. These include attending meeting meetings, riding in parades and being present at the Junction City horse shows.

This young lady must have the desire and the enthusiasm to serve as a representative at all selected events and to hold a high standard of sportsmanship at all times. She should show this with manners, personality, and should have knowledge of equine awareness. This young lady should be able to speak intelligently and display dignity in any situation.

Eligibility

1. Contestants should not be younger than 12 years of age and should not be more than 19 years of age. Age will be shall be determined by January 1st of the competition year.
2. Contestants must be a member of the Junction City Saddle Club.
3. Every contestant (January 1st rule) must have parental/ legal guardian written permission.
4. All participants and parents/ legal guardian must observe and comply with all rules and regulations as they exist now or as they are amended here after.
5. No person shall be a contestant with out an application, and the application must be accepted by a committee member.
6. The queen applicant must be present at the meeting when the queen will be decided. The committee will notify each contestant in advance of the meeting. The committee can decide if the candidate has an acceptable reason to be excused from the requirements.

Selection of Queen

After all of the applications are received, the committee at the next saddle club meeting will give a brief over view and introduce contestants to the attending members. The members will then decide who is to be crowned the new queen. In an event of a tie, the tied contestants will be asked to re join the meeting for as question and answer discussion. The members will then be asked again to decide their next Queen.

The members attending the meeting will make the final decision on their queen. The queen will not be relieved of her duties except in case of emergencies, and other understandable reasons. In this occurrence the members will vote yet again using the previous applications.

Personality and Appearance

Young ladies must meet the following:

1. Grooming, this is includes neatness and cleanliness.
2. Poise and ladylike behavior in every circumstance.
3. Dress appropriately in western attire. Clothing should fit properly and no be too tight or low cut.
